



We look forward to sharing our country with you.




ACCOMMODATION

Award winning Cicada Lodge is a luxurious sanctuary to where you can retreat at the end of a busy day. With just 18 rooms, this private lodge will allow you to get back to nature without sacrificing the creature comforts. Located just a 15 minute walk from the jetty, Cicada Lodge is the perfect place to relax and revive in comfort.

From here you can embrace the ancient landscapes, natural wonders, and Indigenous culture within the iconic

Wake up to the sounds and sights of the native bush or close the full-length doors for the cool privacy of your air-conditioned sanctuary.

In the heart of it all are the Nitmiluk Cabins – spacious 1 or 2 bedroom self-contained apartments. Relax by the pool or chill on your balcony and observe the wildlife. Just 600m from the jetty, the cabins are the perfect place to unwind after a day exploring the wonders of Nitmiluk National Park.

Set on the Nitmiluk campgrounds overlooking the Katherine River, here you'll find the natural beauty of Nitmiluk on your doorstep. You may even encounter wallabies and other local wildlife that pass by.

Choose from ten 1 or 2 bedroom self-contained airconditioned cabins – ideal for couples or families that prefer the convenience of being able to prepare meals to their liking. Only 10 minutes walk to the Gorge Tours Jetty, Nitmiluk Campground offers both powered and unpowered sites, a swimming pool, BBQs and more.

Nitmiluk Campground is the ideal spot to uncover the wonderland that is Nitmiluk National Park.





- The approx. 400m walk each way between the two gorge has steps and uneven ground so may not be suitable for those with mobility issues. Alternatively, you are welcome to wait at the transfer point and return with the rest of the group.
- Toilet facilities are available onboard the vessels but are limited so we do advise using the bathroom before joining the tour.

ARRIVE, AND DINE SETTLE IN

WALKING TRACKS

ITINERARY 2

Food and River Cruise experience in Nitmiluk National Park

DAY 1 WAKE UP WITH THE WILDLIFE

Discover the unspoiled beauty of the morning on our Dawn Cruise Tour, being immersed by the vibrant colours, the soft mist floating above the water, and the sounds of nature waking up.

LATER

Stop over at Nitmiluk Cafe Bistro at the Visitor Centre. With spectacular views over the Katherine River from the outdoor deck, this licensed restaurant offers sit-down menus, a quick bite, coffee and various refreshments.

DAY 2 AFTER BREAKKIE

See the water from on it - in a canoe. Take a short hike through Nitmiluk's first gorge to reach the second, from where the canoes are launched. Then take your time ambling through at least 2 gorges, admiring the scenery and wildlife, enjoy a picnic on the shaded river banks, or cool off with a swim in the azure waters.

SUNSET

Finish off a magical day with Nitmiluk's 'jewel in the crown', the Nabilil Dreaming Sunset Dinner Cruise. Share our history and the culture of the Jawoyn, while indulging in a -3 course candlelit dinner, featuring local Indigenous produce and specialties of the Northern Territory, all cooked fresh on board. Sit back, and relax with an incredible view, and a complimentary glass of bubbles.
